NOTICE TO ALL REGISTERED ACCOUNT HOLDERS

Re: Register for Manitoba Public Insurance Estimating Standards Training

As part of the 2017 Light Vehicle Accreditation Agreement (LVAA) and Proper Repair initiative, accredited repair shops are required to participate in Estimating Standards training.

The training provides an overview of the rules and allowances unique to Manitoba Public Insurance's estimating process as well as explanations and examples of how the standards are applied when producing vehicle damage estimates and supplements.

There is no registration fee for the Estimating Standards training and technicians in an Estimator role will receive up to two I-CAR credits for attending.

All shops are encouraged to register for training as soon as possible in order to ensure efficient and convenient scheduling. Those shops that have signed the 2017 LVAA and have I-CAR Gold Class Professionals designation will be given priority registration.

Repair shops interested in applying for the Direct Repair (DR) program, starting March 1, 2017, must complete the Estimating Standards training to be eligible.
