NOTICE TO ALL COMMERCIAL REPAIR FACILITIES

Re: Recycled and Aftermarket Parts Business Rules – Commercial Vehicles

Manitoba Public Insurance and the Manitoba Commercial Vehicle Repair Association (MCVRA) have been working collaboratively on new Parts Business Rules for medium and heavy truck claims. The new rules introduce Parts Autonomy for commercial accredited repair shops. Parts Autonomy allows commercial accredited repair shops to source parts required for repairs without seeking approval from MPI, as long as the selections are cost-effective parts and meet MPI policies.

As a result, effective March 1, 2018, MPI will no longer broadcast for recycled parts for medium and heavy trucks. Commercial accredited repair shops will be responsible for sourcing cost-effective parts for their repairs.
