



# Journeyperson Requirement for Certified Mechanic Status Survey

MPI is considering implementing the requirement that mechanics issuing certificates of inspection for light vehicles and heavy commercial vehicles hold journeyperson status in their applicable field. The proposal would be applied *only* to new entrants into the inspection programs. Mechanics currently holding a qualified mechanics permit would not be impacted.

We want to ensure that inspection station operators are provided with an opportunity to give feedback to MPI on this potential change. In support of this, we are reaching out through an upcoming survey to those stations that hold valid permits.

In the coming days, an invitation will be emailed to you to provide feedback on your views about the proposed policy change. We ask that you share your thoughts by Friday, November 12.
