

Restocking Fees and Non-Returnable Parts

Rules

MPI will only consider compensation for restocking and non-returnable parts for circumstances outside the shop's control such as the vehicle becoming a total loss due to a second claim.

MPI will consider reimbursing the shop in accordance with the MPI Parts Business Rules and applicable Estimating Standards.

<u>Invoices</u> with itemized costs are required to support all restocking fees and non-returnable parts.

No restocking fees or non-returnable part costs will be considered for Parts Autonomy, or supplier of choice decisions made by the shop. All requests are subject to audit and part selection reviews.

Prior to ordering parts, repair shops must confirm that all parts on the estimate are correct. Ordering parts before obtaining MPI approval to repair, repair blueprinting and/or customer consent is not recommended.

MPI approval is required for any non-returnable parts or restocking fees charged to the claim. MPI will not pay for non-returnable parts, restocking fees, or other related expenses (such as shipping/freight) for parts incorrectly listed on an estimate. In these situations, any costs will be a matter between the part supplier and the repair shop.

Procedure

Restocking Fee or Non-Returnable Part

Follow the steps below to add a restocking fee or non-returnable part to an estimate.

Begin with the estimate open in Mitchell Estimating.

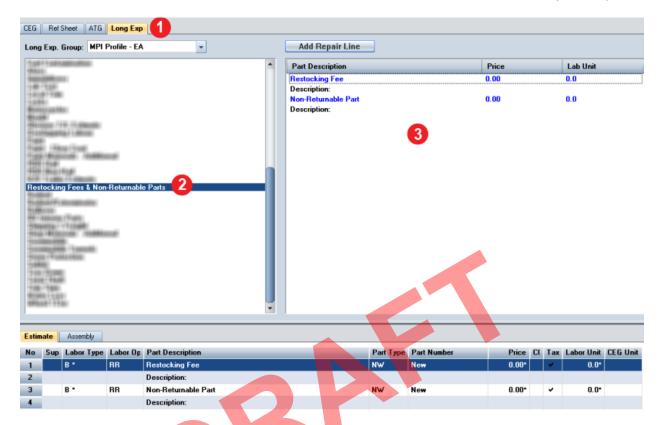
- 1. From the **Repair** tab, select the **Long Exp** sub-tab.
- 2. Select the **Restocking Fees & Non-Returnable Parts** category.
- 3. Under Part Description, select Restocking Fee or Non-Returnable Part.

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- 4. Under the **Price** column, input the cost of the fee as indicated on the supplier's invoice.
 - If the cost exceeds MPI's maximum allowance, calculate the difference and adjust the price.
