

Notice to all Accredited Repair Shops

Revisions to Temporary Extension of Loss of Use Coverage

Date published: August 31, 2023

Loss of Use (LOU) provides up to 30 days of rental vehicle coverage. As <u>previously communicated</u>, this amount was temporarily increased to 60 days in August 2022, due to repair delays caused by parts availability and supply chain issues.

After reviewing repair data, the additional number of days that a vehicle can be rented under a Loss of Use policy will be adjusted. Starting **September 1, 2023**, the LOU coverage limit for non-driveable passenger vehicles will be set at \$1,890 before tax (or \$2,116.80 after tax). In essence, this will provide 45 days of coverage.

Given current parts availability and repair turnaround, 45 days provides reasonable coverage for customers to access a rental vehicle until their vehicle is repaired. This extended coverage will continue to February 29, 2024, at which time the requirement for the extended program will be re-assessed.
