Parts Autonomy Update July 2021

As communicated in the <u>Parts Autonomy Update May 2021</u>, incentive accumulation for Level 3 (future Level 2) began on April 1, 2021. The incentives will be processed by MPI on July 16 reflecting achievements for the quarter spanning April – June, 2021.

Starting this month, you can expect to see the following changes on the RPS scorecards:

- 1. Removal of PA Level 2 group. PA levels should be as follows:
 - "Performance Review" if variance from expected is less than 0
 - "Level 1" if variance is between 0 and 3.99%
 - "Level 2" if variance is 4% or greater
- 2. The wording on the scorecards will be changed to "PA Level 2" rather than "PA Level 3". Refer to the Parts Autonomy Update May 2021 for details.

Please note that the incentive calculation is based on any RPS above the benchmark (Variance greater than 0%).
