# Repair Delays Reminder and Delayed Towing Extension

#### **Repair Delays**

In our continued effort to support the repair industry, MPI would like to remind repair facilities that any repair delays should be reported to the MPI Accredited Repair department (<u>accreditedrepair@mpi.mb.ca</u>), as indicated in the 2021 Light Vehicle Accreditation Agreement. The Temporary Repairs and Repair Delays procedure can be found here: <u>Temporary Repairs and Repair Delays</u>.

Many of these delays are related to availability of parts; in particular, supplemental restraint system (SRS) components. MPI may be able to support a temporary repair solution including delays related to SRS components.

## **Delayed Tow**

MPI is extending the <u>Delayed Towing temporary policy</u> until June 30, 2023.

- Include the claim number and the date for the delayed tow

• When communicating with the customer regarding the reason for the vehicle not being driveable, review the opportunity to complete a temporary repair. To allow the vehicle to be made driveable, follow the <u>temporary repair process</u>.
