

Updated Light Vehicle and PMVI Inspection Station Guidebooks

Vehicle Safety has recently updated the Guidebooks for both the Light Vehicle Inspection and Periodic Mandatory Vehicle Inspection programs. These are now available at [MPIPartners > Vehicle Safety](#). Certified inspection stations are required to download these documents and ensure that all station representatives (qualified mechanics and contact persons) are familiar with the contents.

The specific sections that have been updated are:

- All references to a “certificate” for qualified mechanics and inspection stations have been changed to “permit” to reflect the language contained in regulation.
- The Light Vehicle Inspection program guidebook has been updated to include requirements for motorcycle inspectors in the section on Inspection Mechanic Requirements and Responsibilities.
- Clarification that an inspection mechanic for a station must be a full time employee, present during normal business hours, and cannot perform inspections at other inspection stations.

Permit holders are required to perform thorough and accurate inspections to ensure the integrity of the program. If you require assistance to apply inspection standards, it is your responsibility to contact Vehicle Safety for guidance or additional training.
