

Body Integrity Inspection Station Renewals

Date published: May 25, 2026

Effective June 1, 2026, Body Integrity Inspection Stations must submit all required documents and payment prior to their permit expiration date.

The Vehicle Safety department requires the following to process permit renewals:

- A completed and signed Application Form ([English](#) or [French](#)) for renewal.
- An annual \$100 Body Integrity Station renewal fee.
 - The \$100 renewal fee may be paid by cheque, cash, debit, or credit card.
 - Cheques are payable to **Manitoba Public Insurance**.
 - If paying by credit card, please provide a phone number where you can be reached, so payment can be processed via our secure phone line.
- Provide a current copy of the I-CAR Platinum recognition print-out:
 - I-CAR Platinum in the Steel Structural Technician (SST) role.
 - I-CAR Platinum in the Aluminum Structural Technician (AST) role if inspecting aluminum body vehicles.
- Ensure that your corporation and/or business operating name (trade title) with the [Manitoba Companies Office](#) is active and up to date.

The [Body Integrity Inspection Station Renewal Application Checklist](#) has been created to help ensure all renewal requirements are met. All required documents must be submitted together and through one of the following methods:

- To apply electronically, scan and email completed application(s) to vsi-dealerinfo@mpi.mb.ca.
 - **Please do not** send credit card information by email. Applications emailed with credit card details will be denied.



- To apply by mail or in-person, submit a printed application form and payment (cheque, cash, or credit card authorization form) to:
