



# Email Consent for Drivers and Vehicles Act Notices

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Dealers, Recyclers, and Salespersons permit holders can voluntarily consent to receive notices from the Registrar under *The Drivers and Vehicles Act*, C.C.S.M. c. D104 and *The Highway Traffic Act*, C.C.S.M. c. H60, and their regulations via e-mail.

Providing email consent allows our office to send these notices electronically. Email delivery helps ensure notice is received promptly and provides a convenient way to retain copies of official records.

## How to Consent

Dealer, Recycler, and Salesperson permit applications have been updated to allow applicants to provide consent when applying for a new permit or renewing an existing permit.

Current permit holders who wish to provide consent before their next renewal may do so by completing the **Email Consent for DVA Notices** ([English](#) or [French](#)) form. The form is available on MPIPartners, located on the [Vehicle Safety](#) page under Other Forms.

**Note:** To continue receiving notices by email, permit holders must provide consent each time they renew their permit.

## How to Remove Consent

Permit holders may withdraw their consent at any time by following the process outlined in the Dealers' and Recyclers' Handbook or by reviewing Manage Email Consent for DVA notices located on the [Vehicle Safety](#) page under Other Forms.
