Parts Autonomy Update July 2021

As communicated in the [Parts Autonomy Update May 2021](#), incentive accumulation for Level 3 (future Level 2) began on April 1, 2021. The incentives will be processed by MPI on July 16 reflecting achievements for the quarter spanning April – June, 2021.

Starting this month, you can expect to see the following changes on the RPS scorecards:

1. Removal of PA Level 2 group. PA levels should be as follows:
 - “*Performance Review*” if variance from expected is less than 0
 - “*Level 1*” if variance is between 0 and 3.99%
 - “*Level 2*” if variance is 4% or greater
2. The wording on the scorecards will be changed to “PA Level 2” rather than “PA Level 3”. Refer to the [Parts Autonomy Update May 2021](#) for details.

Please note that the incentive calculation is based on any RPS above the benchmark (Variance greater than 0%).
