

Notice to all Light Vehicle Accredited Repair Shops

Parts Autonomy Update October 2021

The Parts Autonomy program was designed to give repair shops control over parts decisions provided they deliver the same level of savings benchmarked before the program began. The program was rolled out during the summer of 2020 with all Light Vehicle (LV) shops onboarded by October 2020.

As the program has evolved, a number of notices to the trade have been posted to the MPI Partners site. The notices have provided updates on changes to the program, clarifications, and general program information. This material has now been consolidated into a [Parts Autonomy Program Guide](#) and published to the MPI Partners site. The new Parts Autonomy Program Guide also contains additional information not previously released. This includes sections on program standards and management, with further details on corrective action and the use of cost effective parts for shops who have exited from the program.
