

Notice to All Repair Shops and Inspection Stations

Suspension of MPI's Third Party COVID-19 Pandemic Policy

Date published: February 28, 2022

Based on updated guidance in the current public health orders, MPI will be suspending the **Temporary Third Party COVID-19 Pandemic Policy**, effective March 1, 2022.

This means any third-party individual attending an MPI location for interactions where six-foot distance or a plexi-glass separation are not reasonable or practical, will **no longer be required** to share proof of full vaccination or provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test. Third-party individuals include the visiting public (for example, customers), repair shop staff, contractors and consultants.

The following health and safety protocols will remain in place:

- Customers will continue to be asked pre-screening questions when receiving services or attending appointments.
- Masks will continue to be mandatory for all customers.
- Social/physical distancing requirements will remain in place.
