



Notice to all Light Vehicle Accredited Repair Shops

Updated MPI Shop Measures

Date published: April 14, 2021

Effective **April 15, 2021**, Realized Parts Savings (RPS) will replace Alternate Parts Usage (APU) on the shop measures scorecard.

The RPS shop measure was released in conjunction with the parts autonomy program. As part of a soft launch between November 15, 2020 to March 15, 2021, repair shops began receiving a parallel shop measures scorecard that included RPS. This allowed repair shops to focus on maintaining their shop measures performance.

Please review the following updated points:

- RPS is worth 20 points towards your composite score (the same point allocation as APU).
- RPS scoring for one and three month periods are provided on the shop measures scorecard.
- Three month shop RPS scoring must be above 0% to be in good standing for the parts autonomy program.
- You will continue to receive an RPS scorecard based on static calendar year quarters. This scorecard provides information on parts autonomy tier placement and incentives.
