



Periodic Mandatory Vehicle Inspection Program Information Guide Updated

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Vehicle Safety has recently updated the **Periodic Mandatory Vehicle Inspection Program Information Guide**. Please review the guidebook and note the recent changes outlined below:

- Vehicle Types and Inspection requirements update:
 - An inspection must be conducted every four years for oil-well service vehicles used exclusively in the oil or natural gas industry to transport equipment or materials to and from industry facilities or to service or repair those facilities.
 - Farm trailers (not including semi-trailers) owned by a farmer and used exclusively for farm operations have been added as an exemption.
- Station Requirements and Responsibilities updates:
 - Limit one inspection station per address/location.
- Inspection Mechanic Requirements and Responsibilities update:
 - For Truck and Trailer GVWR 4500 - 8900 kg, Bus 11 - 24 passenger: be a Journeyperson in the Transport Truck or Automotive Service Technician.
- Replacement Inspection Certificate steps have been updated.
- Inspection Certificate Administrative Procedures update:
 - Removed requirement to enter customer address on certificates.
- Ordering forms have been updated
